When Collene reached the passage mentioning her aunt, Collene turned and winked at Eileen, Margaret Burns said, adding that Eileen gave her niece a "thumbs-up" which left the audience in tears.

Sister Helen Joseph Maloney, life-long educator

Sister Helen Joseph Maloney, S.S.J., a diocesan school teacher for nearly five decades, died at St. Joseph Convent Infirmary on June 23, 1990. She was 81 years of age.

A Mass of Christian Burial for Sister Helen Joseph was celebrated in the motherhouse chapel on Tuesday, June 26. The principal celebrant was Monsignor Gerard Krieg, who was assisted by Fathers Donald Murphy, William Michatek, Thomas Mull and James Slattery. Interment was in the sisters' section of Holy Sepulchre Cemetery on Wednesday, June 27.

A native of Rochester, Sister Helen Joseph entered the Sisters of St. Joseph congregation from Immaculate Conception Parish in 1930. She graduated from Nazareth Academy and earned her baccalaureate degree at Nazareth College.

Among the diocesan schools in which she taught during 49 years were: Immaculate Conception, St. Monica, St. John the Evangelist on Ridge Road, and St. Ambrose, all of Rochester; St. Francis de Sales, Geneva; St. Joseph, Wayland; Ss. Peter and Paul, Elmira; St. Alphonsus, Auburn; and Holy Trinity, Webster.

Sister Helen Joseph also taught at St. Mary's Boys' Home in Rochester, which later became St. Joseph's Villa.

Friends of Sister Helen Joseph said she had a gift for working with children, and was greatly respected by all who knew her.

She retired from teaching in 1981 and resided at St. Joseph Convent Infirmary

to be torn cartilage — which would have required surgery and put her out of training and competition for an extended period of time.

Instead, the injury proved only to be a pinching of the membrane surrounding the knee, and it could be treated with physical therapy and weight training. The accident taught her some valuable lessons.

"I learned that weight training is a very important part of the program," Eichelberger said. "It also taught me that upper body strength is important."

If Eichelberger does make it to the nationals next spring, she would then be ready to move up to the seniors level in competition, and perhaps a return to the nationals. And with 1992 approaching, the question naturally arises: does she have a shot at the Olympics.

Bond does not think so. "It's doubtful because of the number of good competitors," Bond said.

When asked to assess her chances of reaching the Olympics, Eichelberger laughed and said her focus was on the nationals. "It's too tough," she said.

Her own long-term goals are simpler. "I want to coach," she said. "I just like to help other skaters and beginners."

Fr. Venard Christy, former science teacher

Father Venard L. Christy, 68, a member of St. Andrew's Seminary faculty between 1961-67, died suddenly in Old Forge, N.Y., on July 5, 1990.

The former science teacher had returned to his hometown after retiring in 1983 from the Christian Brothers Academy in Syracuse.
