Father Leo Klem, CSB, celebrates golden anniversary

ROCHESTER — Father Leo J. Klem, CSB, will celebrate the 50th anniversary of his ordination to priesthood during a 2 p.m. Mass at St. Thomas More Church on Saturday, Aug. 18. A reception will follow from 3-5 p.m. at the Basilian residence, 3497 East Ave.

An Irondequoit native, Father Klem, 76, attended school at St. Monica, St. Joseph and St. Thomas the Apostle schools. He went to St. Michael's College School in Toronto before joining the Basilians in 1931. He then attended the University of Toronto, where he studied French and German. After earning his master's degree, he was ordained in 1940, and later

completed his theological studies at the Grand Seminaire in Quebec City.

Father Klem taught at Aquinas Institute from 1941-42 and then at St. Michael's College School from 1942-48.

During the years 1961-73, Father Klem taught at St. John Fisher College, and served as chairman of the Modern Languages Department.

In 1973, Father Klem began a new career, conducting sessions in the Marriage Encounter movement. In 1982, he took on work in the Engaged Encounter movement and since 1986, he has been working with Retrouvaille, a program for troubled marriages.
