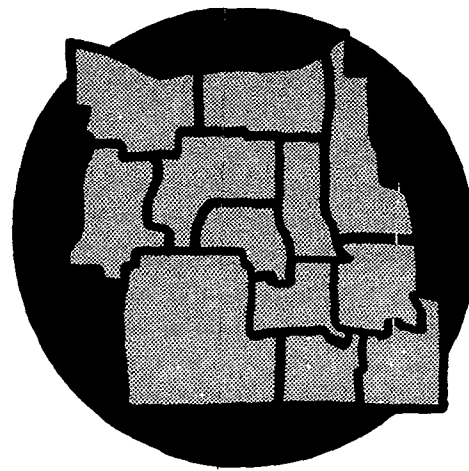
Pro-life group plans service for Good Friday

ROCHESTER — The Pro-Life Planning Committee has scheduled Stations of the Cross for Good Friday, March 29, beginning with a prayer service at St. Boniface Church, 330 Gregory St., at 9 a.m.

After the half-hour service, several diocesan priests and deacons will lead participants to a facility where abortions are performed, according to organizers. Participants will perform the Stations of the Cross in front of the "place that commits abortion," according to a statement the group released March 9.

The pro-life committee emphasized in its statement that "this is not a rescue and we will be breaking no laws on that day." Organizers stated that the group will pray to end abortion at the facility, and for "peace and healing" for women who have had abortions at the clinic. In addition, participants will pray to "change the hearts of the abortionists operating there," the group said.
