

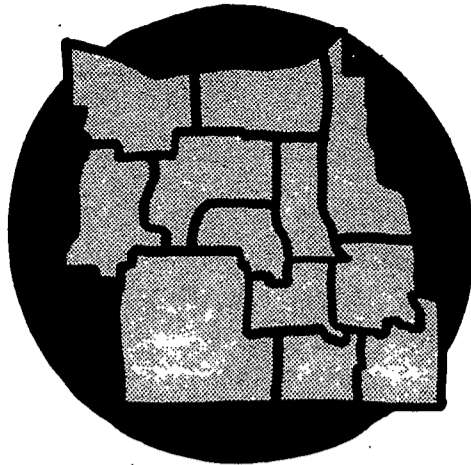
Ss. Peter and Paul plans shower for Melita House

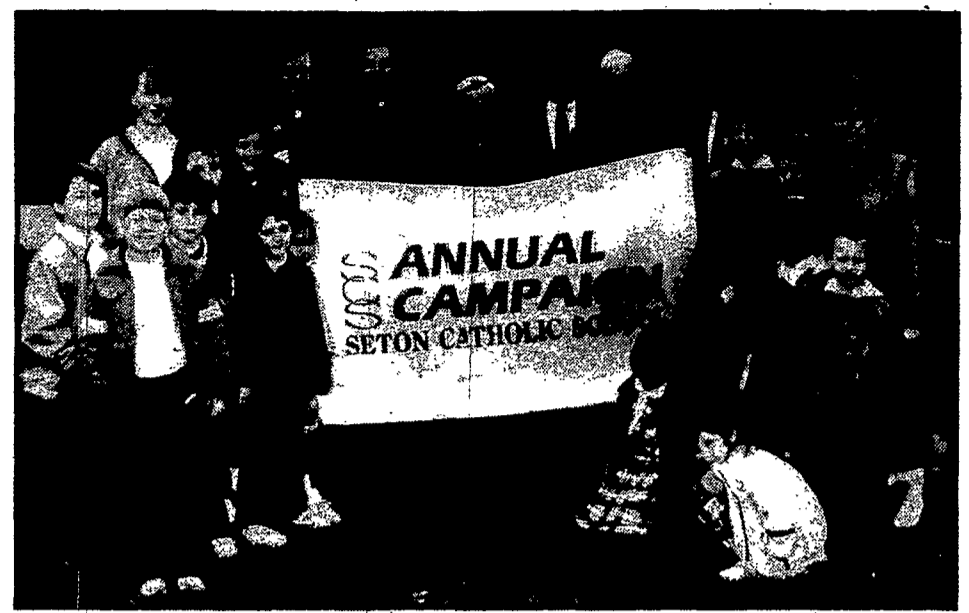


Hoop standouts to attend sports banquet in Auburn

Census bureau head set to speak at parish forum

ROCHESTER — As part of the ongoing Downtown Community Forum series at St. Mary's Church, 15 St. Mary's Place, a program concerning the U.S. census will take place at Rochester Plaza Hotel downtown on Tuesday, May 7.
