

# Lax teams continue to stumble

ROCHESTER — The lacrosse teams at McQuaid Jesuit and Bishop Kearney haven't found the going easy this spring.

McQuaid Jesuit (2-6) recorded its second win of the season on April 27 as the Knights trounced visiting Waterloo, 5-1.

Steve Paul iced three goals for the Knights. Rob Warren finished with three assists.

Senior goalie Ben Hirokawa made eight saves in goal for McQ.

On April 25, the host Knights fell to state-ranked Geneva, 12-3. The Panthers came into the game ranked No. 15 in the latest New York State Sportswriters' Association poll of Class B lacrosse teams.

Paul notched all three goals for the Knights.

Earlier in the week, McQuaid took a 12-5 beating against host Pittsford, 12-5.

The Vikings, who compete in the Monroe County Lacrosse League, took a 9-1 lead in the first half. The Knights scored four goals in the second half, but they were never able to make it close.

Bishop Kearney (1-9) continued to struggle last week as the Kings dropped all three of their games.

On April 26, host Mynderse Academy nipped the Kings, 9-8.

Phillips paced the Kings with one goal and two assists, Kenney notched one goal and one assist, Coil and Mercury added a goal and Coughlin contributed with an assist.

McDonald finished with 14 saves, while Winarski was credited with one stop.
