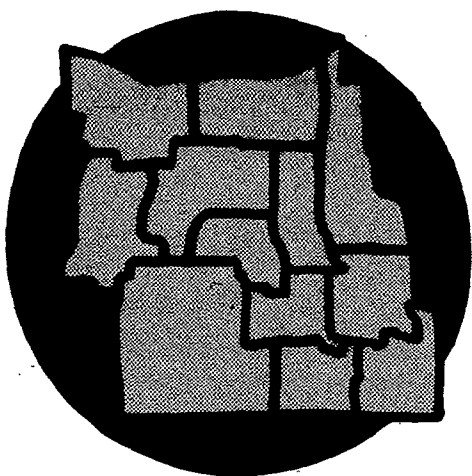

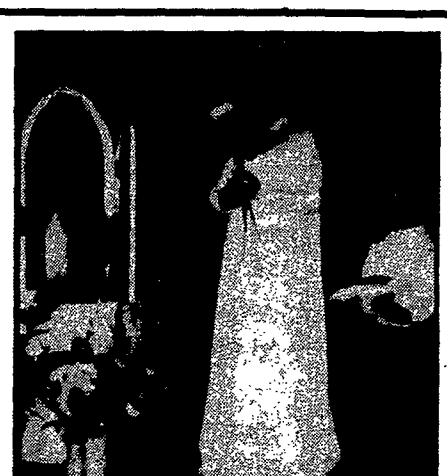


DePaul plans golf tourney for country club in LeRoy
