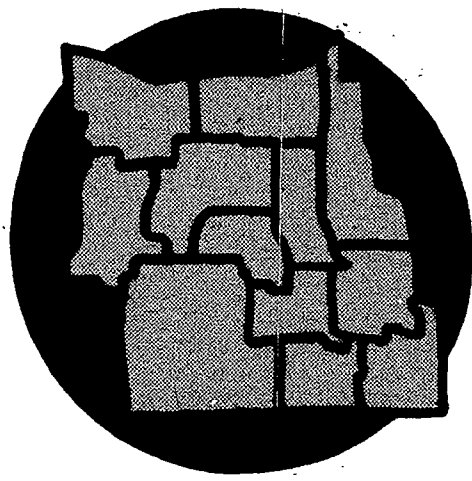
Participants should bring bag lunches. A \$2 per-person offering would be appreciated to help defray the cost of accommodations at the monastery. Transportation assistance can be provided.
