Her presentation will focus on African-American History Month.

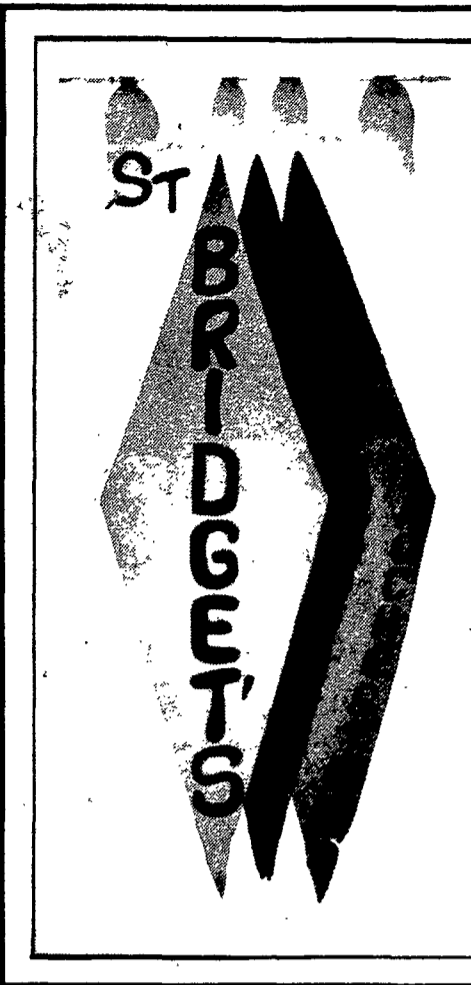
The following Sunday, Feb. 2, the parish will host a "Youth Celebration," also commemorating African-American history, during its 11 a.m. Mass.

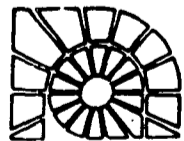
