

Robert R. Dwelley, area composer and conductor, 42

Robert R. Dwelley, a well-known conductor and composer in the Rochester area and an instructor at Rochester Institute of Technology, died Wednesday, Jan. 15, 1992, after a long illness. He was 42 years old.

In addition to serving on the faculty at the former St. Bernard's Seminary, Mr. Dwelley directed the music for the installation of Bishop Matthew H. Clark in 1979.

He also served on the Music and Liturgical Commissions of the Rochester diocese, and was a consultant to the Bishops' Committee on the Liturgy in Washington.

Mr. Dwelley moved to Rochester in

1973 after receiving his bachelor's degree from Loyola University in New Orleans, La. He received his doctorate from the Eastman School of Music in 1985.

Mr. Dwelley was founding music director of Madrigalia, a chamber chorus in Rochester, and Rochester Festival Orchestra, a professional ensemble. He also served as music director of the Finger Lakes Symphony, Hornell Symphony, Brighton Light Opera and several local church choirs.

A frequent guest conductor

throughout western New York, Mr. Dwelley appeared with Brockport Symphony Orchestra, Penfield Symphony Orchestra and other ensembles nationwide.

Mr. Dwelley is survived by his wife, Mary; his parents, Joseph and Mary Virginia of Concord, N.H.; a brother, Michael Kesti of California; and many relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial for Mr. Dwelley was celebrated on Saturday, Jan. 25, at St. John the Evangelist Church in Rochester

Sister Frances Masiello, MFP, 80 years old; former teacher, superior in Watkins Glen

Sister Frances Masiello, MFP, who taught at St. Mary of the Lake School in Watkins Glen from 1966-74, died of kidney failure in Morristown, N.J., on Sunday, Jan. 12, 1992. She was 80.

A Mass of Christian Burial for Sister Frances was celebrated in St. Lucy Chapel in Morristown on Jan. 15, 1992.

Born Sept. 13, 1911, in Jersey City, N.J., Sister Frances entered the Religious Sisters Filipini on Jan. 25, 1925. She made her final profession of vows on July 5, 1931.

In addition to teaching at the Watkins Glen Catholic school, she also

served as the superior of the Religious Sisters Filipini at St. Mary's from 1972-74. She also served in several pastoral ministries during her eight years at the Southern Tier parish.

In 1977, Sister Frances retired to Villa Walsh in Morristown.

Sister Frances is survived by two brothers, Frank Masiello of Toms River, N.J., and Joseph Masiello of Moonachie, N.J.; as well as two nieces and one nephew.


Interment was in Villa Walsh Cemetery.
