Mercy JVs end season with impressive record

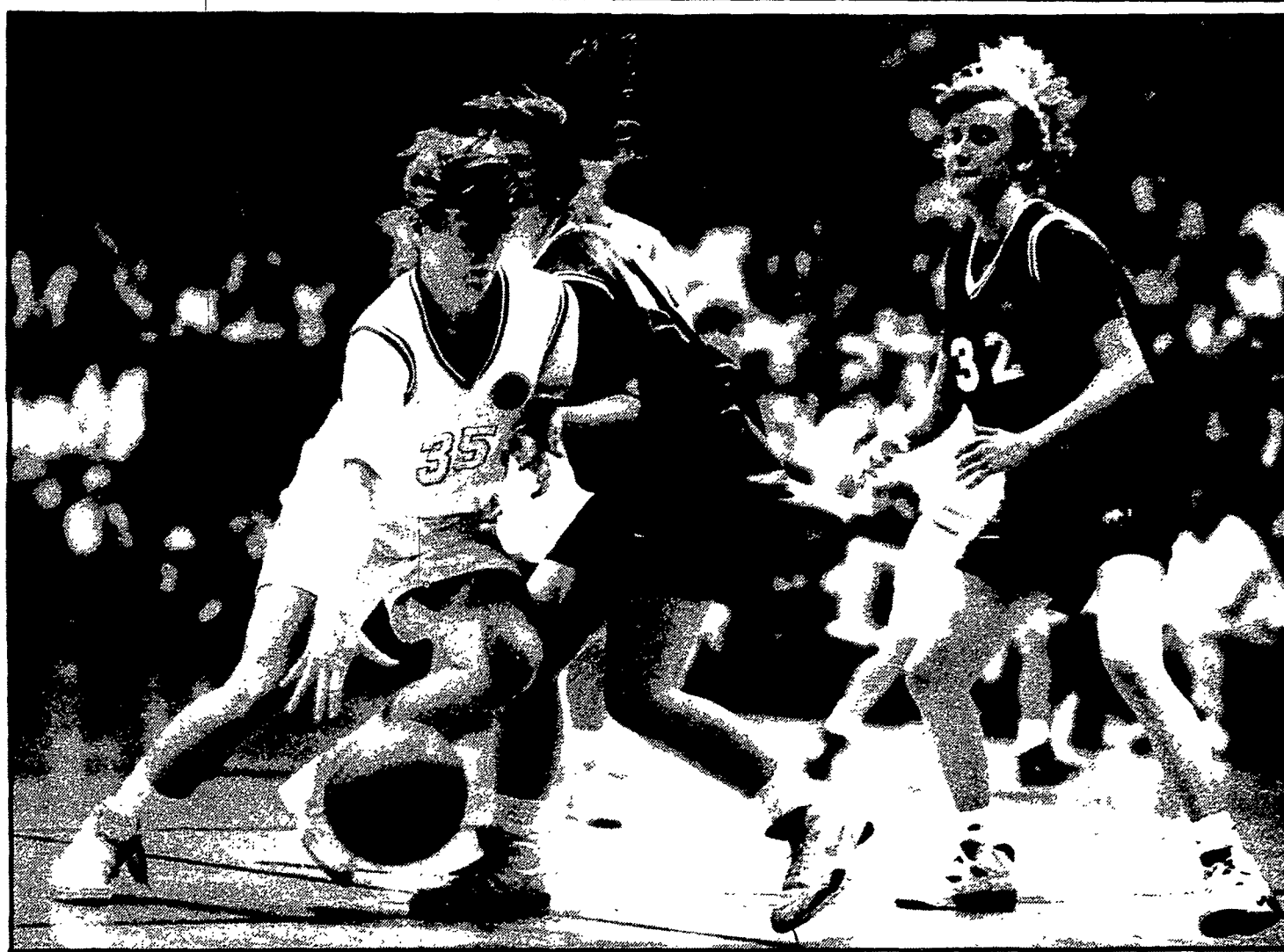
Our Lady of Mercy High School had one of the top junior varsity girls' basketball teams in the Rochester area this year.

Freshman forward Karen Black led a balanced offense with 8.6 points per game. Freshman center Teresa Hartman was second in scoring with 7 PPG. She was followed by sophomore guard Cassie Shea, who averaged 6.8 PPG.

Other top players included sophomore Tricia Russell and freshman Danni LaMagna, who split point guard duties, and sophomore forward Michelle McLaren.

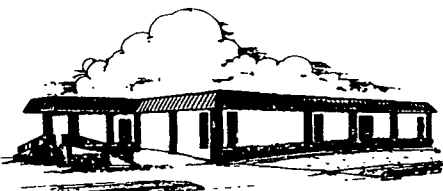

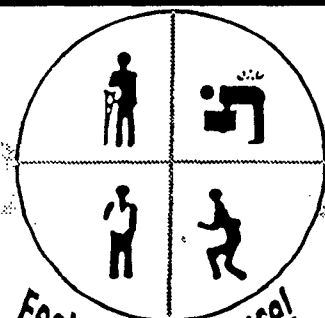

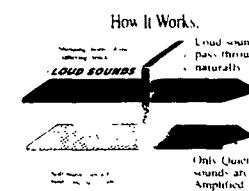
