Catholic Charities USA is the designated Roman Catholic Church agency for disaster response efforts in the United States. The Social Ministry office of the Diocese of Rochester is a

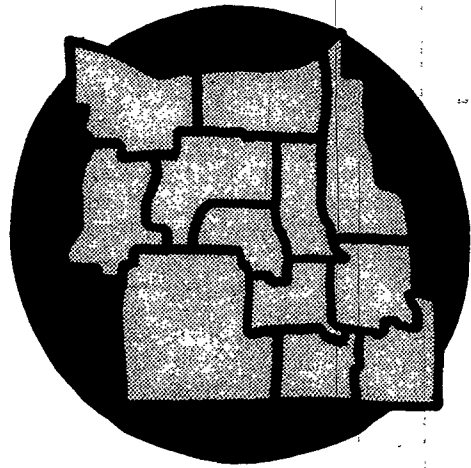
member of the Catholic Charities USA network.

Priest to celebrate Mass marking death of mystic

ROCHESTER — Marking the 30th anniversary of the death of German stigmatist Therese Neumann, Father Donald J. Murphy will celebrate an 8 p.m. Mass at St. Pius the Tenth Parish, 3032 Chili Ave., on Friday, Sept. 18.

Born in 1898, Neumann began experiencing ecstatic visions of the Passion of Christ during Lent, 1926. Generally lasting from two to 15 minutes, these occasional episodes would end with her sometimes voicing what she said were Christ's counsels and orders to others, or announcements of future events.

A personal acquaintance of Neumann, Father Murphy visited her several times during and after World War II. The record of his visits has been translated into German and are part of the records being used in Neumann's beatification process.
