On Election Day, Nov. 3, Giddings will work the polls at the Lyons Community Center from 6 a.m. until 9 p.m. A parishioner of St. Michael in Lyons, Giddings is also involved in an area foster grandparenting program.

Voter registration forms must be postmarked by October 9

According to officials at the Monroe County Board of Elections, registration forms to vote in the Tuesday, Nov. 3 election must be postmarked no later than Oct. 9, 1992.

Anyone who has never voted before must register in order to vote.

Anyone who has changed his or her address since last voting — even to a different apartment in the same building — or who has not voted in the past five consecutive elections must re-register.

The voter registration forms may be obtained at libraries, town halls and many supermarkets, or can be obtained by mail from the board of elections in each county.

In addition, some county board of elections are sponsoring special registration sessions, which are permitted under state election law as late as Oct. 10. In Monroe County, for example, the board of elections will sponsor registration tables or booths Oct. 9-10 at a number of libraries, town halls, county offices and at the board's headquarters, 39 Main St. W.
