Grand opening celebrates Rochester airport's expansion

More than 4,000 people gathered for the grand-opening festivities at the Greater Rochester International Airport Sept. 27. The four-hour celebration featured a weather-balloon launch, a model airplane exhibit, guided airfield and terminal tours, a Veterans' Memorial dedication, a military aircraft display and music by the Brighton Symphony Orchestra. In response to peaceful demonstrators on hand distributing literature about the controversial airport art program and stickers that read "Let the Art Land Too," Monroe County Executive Robert King announced his support for the proposal prior to the ribbon-cutting. The airport, which had been under renovation for the past three years, now boasts a three-level parking garage, a business and travel center, an interfaith chapel, and a food court with specialty stores.
