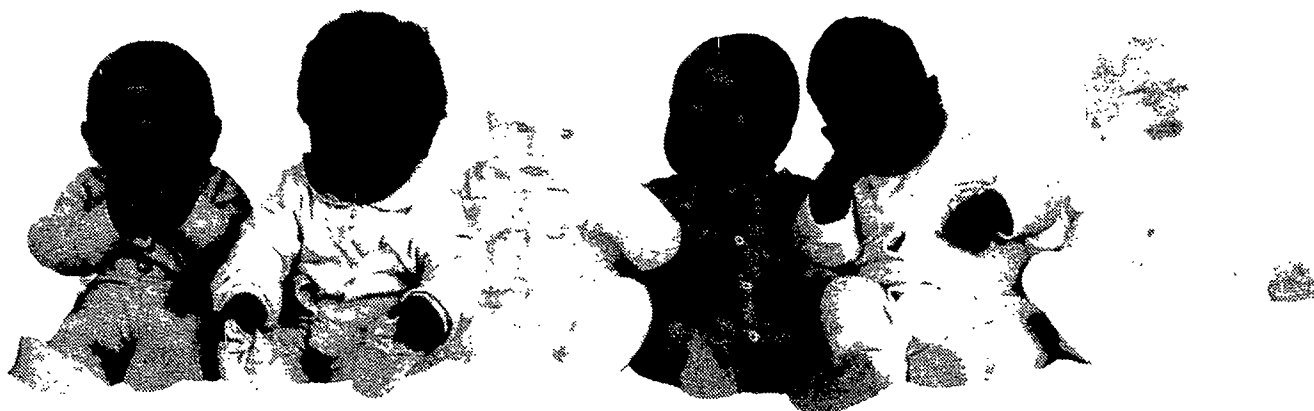


# Vote **FOR LIFE** Tuesday, November 3rd **BECAUSE** Almost Every Third Baby Dies from Abortion
