

# Lupus. The Hidden Disease That Lasts A Lifetime.

Over 500,000 people in the United States have Lupus, and 50,000 new cases are diagnosed each year. More people are affected by Lupus than by leukemia, cystic fibrosis, muscular dystrophy or AIDS. Men and women of any age can develop Lupus, but it most frequently strikes women of childbearing age.

Typical symptoms include:

- Painful and swollen joints • Frequent unexplained fever • Fatigue • Anemia • Sun-sensitive skin
- Red skin rashes • Abnormal hair loss • Blanching of fingers when cold

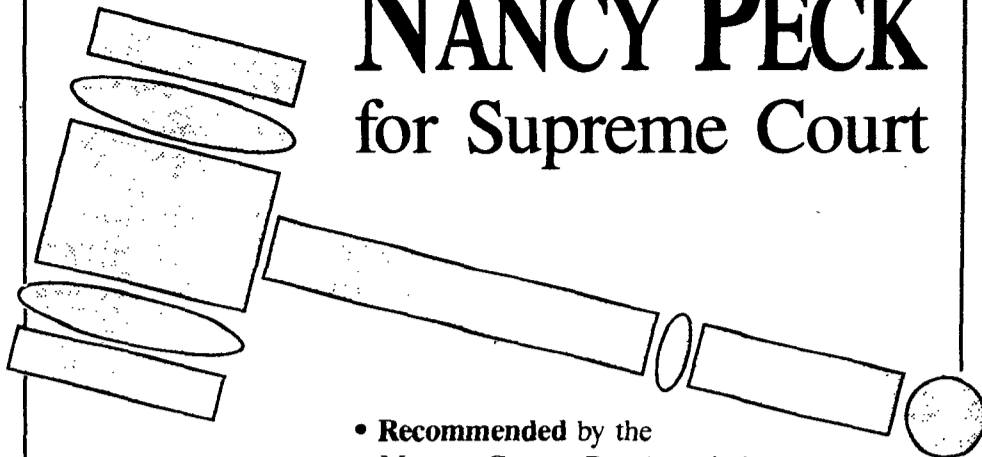

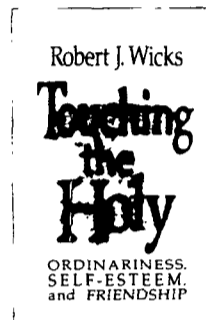
