
Almost Every Third Baby Dies from Abortion




"I set before you Life and Death, the blessing and the curse; Choose Life then that you and your descendants may live." Deuteronomy 30:19

Bill Clinton

- Bill Clinton now says he would sign legislation to restore federal tax funding of abortion. This contradicts earlier positions he took against tax funding of abortion. Clinton has now proposed a national plan to fund all abortions. (AR Gazette 7/16/91, NY Post 1/14/92, Clinton letter 9/26/86)
- Bill Clinton will make support for the current policy of abortionon-demand a litmus test for appointments to the U.S. Supreme Court. (Bill Moyers interview 7/92)

☐ Ross Perot

- Ross Perot has said he would sign the same radical legislation Clinton supports which would guarantee abortion for any reason ...even as a method of birth control or for sex selection. (Today Show 5/18/92)
- Ross Perot supports tax funding of abortion. (Meet the Press 5/3/92)

George Bush

- ★ George Bush supports legal protection for unborn children and supports lifesaving alternatives such as adoption.
- ★ George Bush supports parental consent laws and has called proposals to allow minors to obtain abortions without parental consent "crazy."
- ★ George Bush opposes tax funding of abortion. He has successfully vetoed every attempt by Congress to use public funds to promote or pay for abortions.
- ★ George Bush's administration has urged the U.S. Supreme Court to allow legal protection for unborn children. The Bush Administration has also filed successful briefs urging the U.S. Supreme Court to uphold pro-life state legislation such as parental notification and informed consent laws.
