Noted musicians to play at Pittsford church

PITTSFORD — "Lessons and Carols," the second musical event in a series, will be presented at St. Louis Church, 60 S. Main St., on Sunday, Dec. 13, at 2:30 p.m.

Guest artists Mitzie Collins (dulcimer), Glenda Dove (flute) and Roxanne Ziegler (harp) will join with the St. Louis Adult and Children's Choir and Handbell Ensemble as well as Linda Keefe (flutist) in a program of Advent and Christmas seasonal music and scriptural readings.

Collins is the founder of Sampler Records Ltd., an independent record label specializing in acoustic folk music. She has produced and/or performed on more than 25 recordings. She was also director of music for Colgate Rochester Divinity School from 1970-74, and served as director of music for Protestant ser-

vices at the University of Rochester Interfaith Chapel for four years.

Ziegler teaches adults and children at Park Avenue Suzuki Studio in Rochester and plays at many weddings as well as corporate and private celebrations. Together with Collins, she was a featured performer at the 1988 and 1990 International Conferences of Folk Harpers and Craftsmen. Her new record, "Romantic Favorites for Solo Harp," was scheduled for release in November.

Dove is currently on the faculties of the Hochstein School of Music and of the State University of New York at Geneseo. The freelance musician is also a member of the Geneseo Wind Quintet. She was featured on "Be Thou My Vision," Sampler Records' recent release of favorite hymns for the dulcimer.

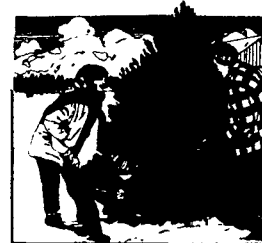
First prize in the raffle is a trip to Rome accompanying the choir. The trip is valued at \$1,900. Several other prizes will be awarded.
