Institute to help teachers influence inner-city youths

WASHINGTON (CNS) — Twenty-three Catholic inner-city school teachers and urban youth ministry workers have been invited to participate in an experimental institute designed to help them influence the spiritual and moral development of inner-city children.

The July 18-30 institute in Boston, called "Teaching for Spiritual Growth," is a joint

project of the National Catholic Educational Association, the Jesuit-sponsored Weston School of Theology, and Foundations and Donors Interested in Catholic Activities.

Harvard professor Robert Coles, whose work has focused on the spiritual and moral formation of children, will participate in the institute, which developed from a con-

versation between him and the FADICA board.

Other faculty members will include Jesuit Father Brian McDermott and Franciscan Sister Margaret Eletta Guider of the Weston School of Theology; Shawn Copeland, a Catholic professor at the Yale School of Divinity; Father Bruce Wall, a pastor and juvenile court magistrate in Boston; Lorraine Monroe of the Bank Street School of Education in New York; Robert Kegan and Laura Maciuka of the Harvard Graduate School of Education; Sharon Parks of the Harvard Business School; and Jesuit Father Charles Shelton of Regis College.

This 13-day institute is receiving its funding from eight member foundations of FADICA.

Kearney's Chris Regan wins debating title

IRONDEQUOIT — Simply put, Chris Regan says it best.

Regan, a senior at Bishop Kearney High School, 125 Kings Hwy. S., talked his way to a first-place finish at the National Catholic Forensic League Championships. This prestigious national debating event was held May 28-31 in Boca Raton, Fla.

Regan defeated approximately 200 competitors in his category to become the first national forensics champion from the Rochester area since the mid-1960s.

Regan was one of eight Kearney students who qualified for the national competition in Florida. Regan and senior Norma Holland were the only BK participants to reach the final elimination rounds.

Also representing Kearney were senior Ron Torrance, juniors Monica Bradbury, Michael Johnson and Camille Joseph; and sophomores Elizabeth DeMatteis and David Jones.

Joining the Kearney eight at

the nationals were four students from McQuaid Jesuit High School, 1800 Clinton Ave. S., Brighton.

Two members of that McQuaid quartet, senior Jon Maurer and junior Chris Zwahlen, made it to the final rounds. McQ's other two participants were senior Jason Lucas and sophomore Mike Doerrer.

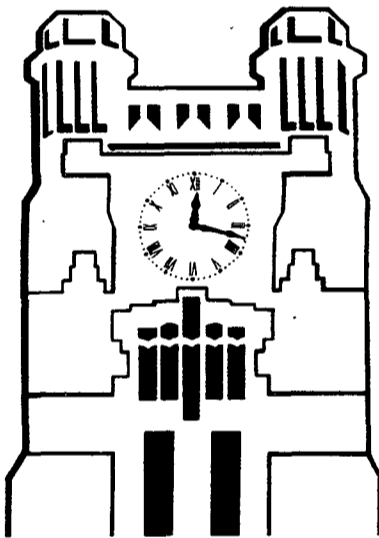
