## Sisters of St. Joseph moving Trinity Montessori to East Rochester

PITTSFORD — After 22 years at the Sisters of St. Joseph Motherhouse, 4095 East Ave., Trinity Montessori School is moving next week to the former St. Jerome School, 501 S. Garfield St., East Rochester.

Sister Clare Francis Mogenhan, SSJ, principal, said the move was necessary because the school needed more room

and because the motherhouse's central administration needed more room for its offices.

"More sisters are retiring and want to live at the motherhouse," she added.

Currently, the school occupies a first-floor wing of the motherhouse and one other room in its lower level. Sister Mogenhan said Trinity Montessori would move Aug. 16

into the upper and lower floors of what was once St. Jerome's primary school wing.

Trinity Montessori boasts an enrollment of 86 students, and the move to St. Jerome will enable it to increase that number by 20, she said.
