vicar at the Northern Cayuga Cluster (1991-93). He has been on medical leave of absence since April 1993.

Father William D. Lum was born June 8, 1943, in Rochester. He attended Sacred Heart School, and St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. He was ordained June 7, 1969, at Sacred Heart Cathedral.

Father Lum served as associate pastor of St. Margaret Mary Church in Irondequoit (1969-73) and St. Louis Church in Pittsford (1973-75). He became chaplain at the University of Rochester in 1975, and served in that capacity until 1990. During that time he was also director of diocesan campus ministry, from 1978-80 and again from 1984-90.

Father Lum was parochial vicar at Holy Cross Church in Rochester (1990-91) and administrator at St. Joseph's Church in Penfield (1991). He began his present assignment, as pastor of Greece's Our Lady of Mercy Church, in 1991.

Father Richard Masciangelo, CPPS, is a native of Niles, Ohio. He came to Rochester in 1962 when he attended St. John Fisher College.

Father Masciangelo professed his vows in the Society of the Precious Blood in 1963. He attended St. Bernard's Seminary and was ordained on April 26, 1969, in Ohio.

Father Masciangelo served at St. Roch Church in Toronto, Ont., (1969-71), and as formation director at the House of Studies in Rochester (1971-73). He was then pastor of St. Anthony of Padua Church in Rochester (1973-76) before serving in various roles at Bishop Ludden (1976-79) and Bishop Grimes (1979-81 and 1982-84) high schools in Syracuse.

He later served as parochial vicar of Most Precious Blood Church in Rochester (1981-82 and 1984-86) before becoming pastor of St. Jerome's Church in East Rochester in 1986. Father Masciangelo is leaving that position this week to become pastor of St. Lawrence Church in Greece.

Father Mark A. Miller was born on June 19, 1943. He attended St. Thomas the Apostle School in Irondequoit, and St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. His ordination took place June 7, 1969, at Sacred Heart Cathedral.

Father Miller served as parochial vicar at St. Ambrose Church in Rochester (1969-72), Ss. Peter and Paul Church in Elmira (1972-74), and St. Helen's Church in Gates (1974-78).

Since 1983, Father Miller has served as adjunct assistant professor of church history for St. Bernard's Institute. During that time he has also been parochial vicar at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church in Rochester (1982-83), St. Philip Neri Church in Rochester (1983-84), St. James Church in Irondequoit (1984-90), Good Shepherd Church in Henrietta (1992), and St. Ann's Church in Hornell from 1993 through the present.

Father Richard J. Shatzel was born on Sept. 28, 1943. He attended Holy Apostles School in Rochester, and St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. He was ordained on June 7, 1969, at Sacred Heart Cathedral.

Father Shatzel served as parochial vicar at St. James Church in Waverly (1969-73), St. Boniface Church in Rochester (1973-78), and Our Mother of Sorrows Church in Greece (1978-82).

He moved to Auburn in 1982, where he became parochial vicar at both Holy Family and St. Aloysius churches. In 1986 Father Shatzel returned to Rochester to become pastor of St. Philip Neri Church — a role in which he has since remained.
