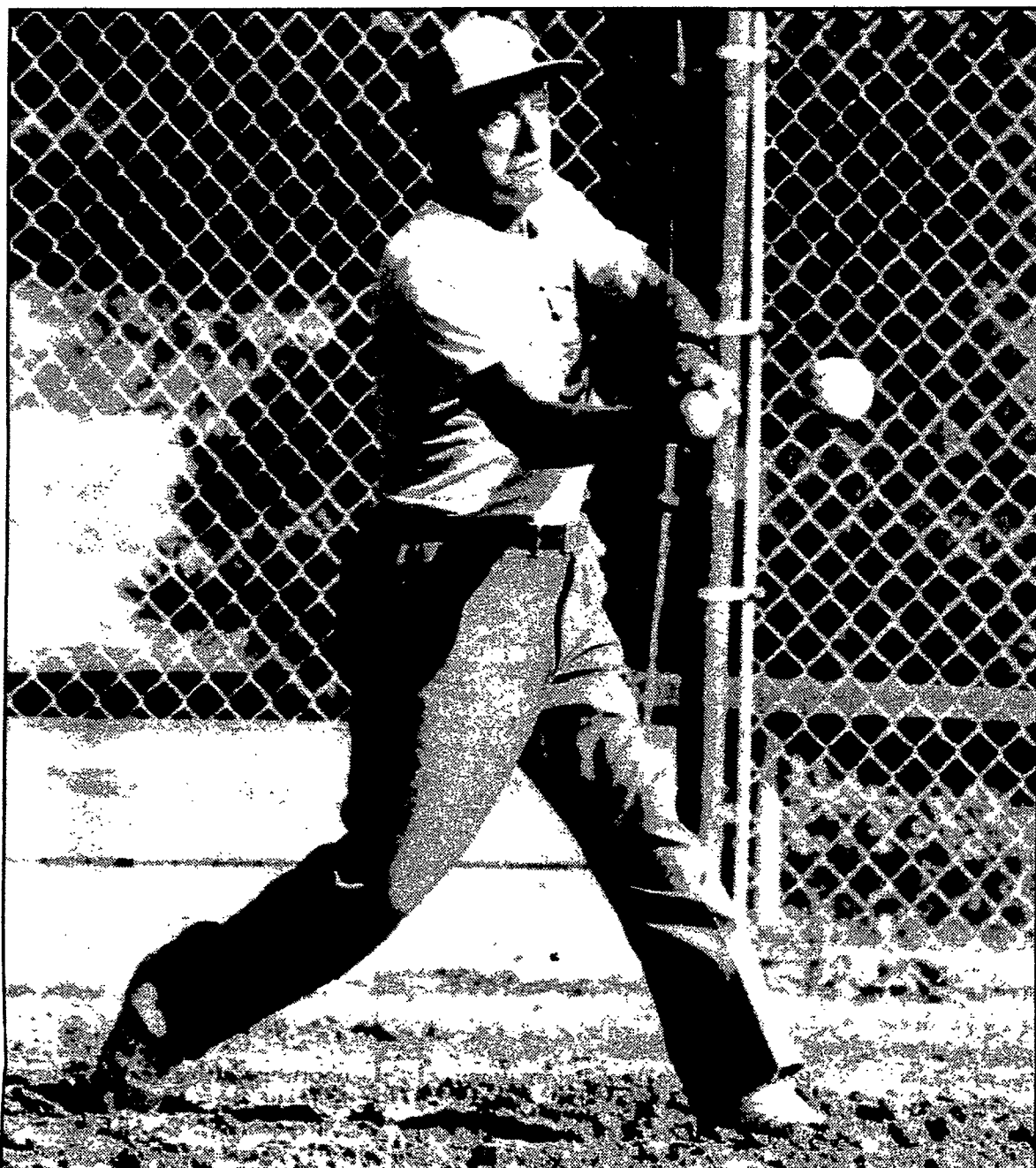


Seniors swing into action
