A second copy of the report will be submitted to Albany in anticipation of a Governor's Conference on aging tentatively scheduled for March, 1995. That conference, however, was scheduled by lame duck Gov. Mario Cuomo's office. Kenny said at this point she did not know if Gov.-elect George Pataki will continue plans to hold the conference.

In addition, several delegates will also take part in the conferences to emphasize local seniors' viewpoints, Kenny said.


