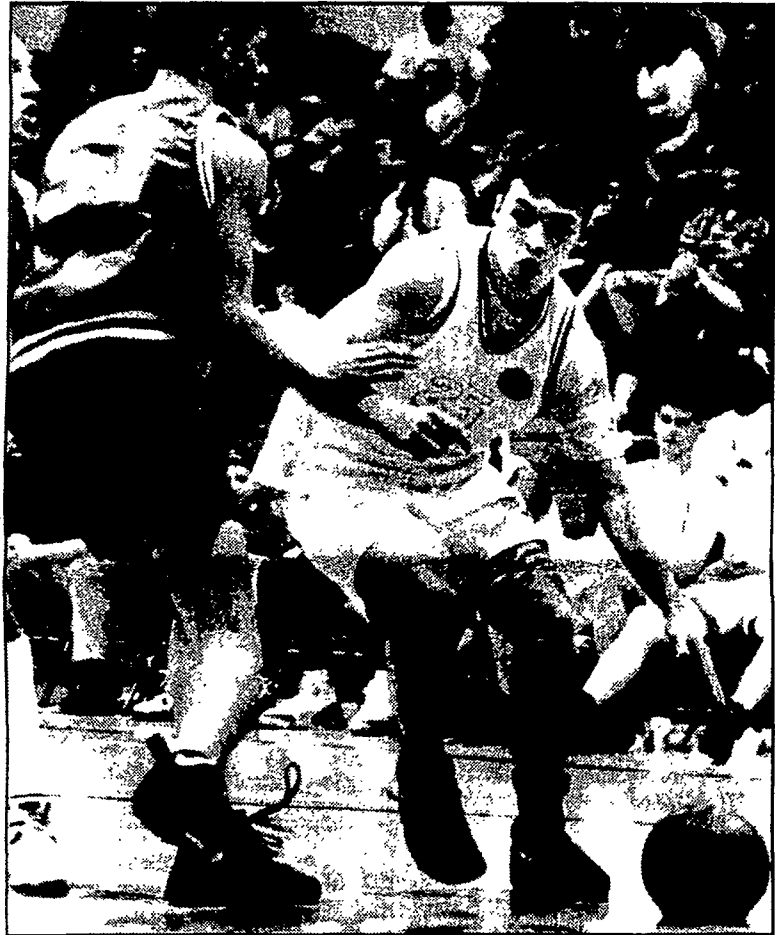


Stars shine for good cause
