

## Program bridges generations

Generations Elder and Child Care Center, located in the former Holy Ghost School, 230 Coldwater Road, Rochester, provides day-care services for both senior citizens and young children. The adult day-care program is designed for senior citizens (ages 55 and over) who cannot manage all the daily tasks associated with independent living. In addition to regular care, the center offers intergenerational activities such as baking, arts and crafts, and games bringing together seniors and young children. According to Eve M. Moses, executive director, the center is planning to open an additional facility in the current Most Precious Blood School building on Stenson Street in Rochester.

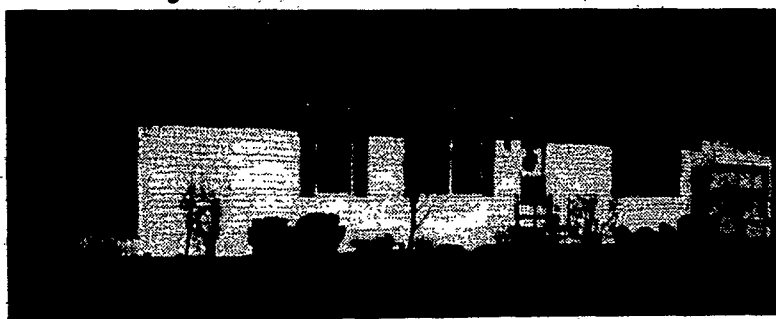
