# Title hopes surge high in diocesan girls' track

"Encouraging" is how Our Lady of Mercy Coach Tim Jones labeled his track and field team's recent third-place showing at the Pittsford Relays.

Now Jones hopes his Monarchs have gained enough confidence to finish a notch or two higher next Saturday, May 27, when Mercy will compete in the Section 5 championship meet at Gates-Chili High School.

"Newark is the team to beat, but everything considered, I think we're in the hunt," Jones predicted.

Bolstered by its usual superior depth, Mercy will enter sectionals as the 1995 Private-Parochial League champion.

The Monarchs' top event is the 3,200-meter relay consisting of junior Jessie Dugan, sophomore Lindsay Wegman, and seniors Danni LaMagna and Christine DeMott. This unit blew the field away at the May 13 Pittsford Relays, posting a winning time of 10 minutes, 5.4 seconds. Second-place Rush-Henrietta was a full 13.1 seconds behind.

Wegman and LaMagna also perform individually in the 800 and 1,500, with Dugan in the 800 and DeMott in the 400 run and 100 high hurdles. Other top Monarchs are seniors Kathryn Belgioro (3,000), Jen Neill (discus), Julie Schneider (discus), and Thon Dickerson (high jump); juniors Erica Hames (high jump) and Jen Delibert (long jump); sophomores Gina DeBergalis (400 intermediate hurdles), Lindsay Pierce (shot put), Meg Ahern (triple jump), and Monique Golossi (triple jump); freshmen Teresa Jones and Christina Brasser (400 hurdles); and eighth-grader Ellen Delibert.

An improving Aquinas Institute squad won a May 10 meet against Nazareth Academy, 75-57, after losing 66-64 to the Lasers back on April 24.

"I think the girls have the potential to be a powerhouse — to give Mercy a run for their money within a year or two," said Coach Joe Merenda, whose Little Irish fell 87-45 to the Monarchs May 8.

Juniors Shola Owodunni (long jump, 100, 200) and Sue Potter (triple and high jumps, 100 hurdles, 100) are two of AQ's most talented and versatile performers. Other top Little Irish include freshmen Sue Reifsteck (shot put, discus, 400), Kelly Bill (discus), Maureen O'Connor (400, 800, 100 hurdles), Lindsay Callahan (100 hurdles), and Bridgette Zakielarz (3,000);

sophomore Tacy Amering (1,500); and senior Fran Mance (1,500).

Aquinas also boasts a speedy 400 relay in Reifsteck, junior Jill Evenski, sophomore Karen Guerand, and Owodunni.

At Nazareth Academy, junior Karen Scozzafava could be the finest 3,000-meter runner in the Section 5 area. She recorded a 10:44.4 — more than 15 seconds ahead of second-place Carrie Cocco of Fairport — in winning the Pittsford Relays. Scozzafava also runs the 1,500.

Other top Lasers are eighth-grader Christina Brown (100, 200); freshmen Kelly Wergin (200), Monique Biggiam (100), Wakisha Bailey (400, 800), Amy Gontarek (400), Danielle LeSure (shot put), Christine O'Connor (high and triple jumps), Allison Ince (high and long jumps), and Diana Carmen (100 hurdles, long jump); sophomore Jennifer Knitter (discus); and juniors Shari Karlowski (1,500, 3,000), Melissa Brinkman (800), Lena Palluconi (discus), Christina Jakymowycz (shot put, triple jump), and Stacy Keech (100 and 400 hurdles).

Coach Dave Turek believes that an abundance of youth and numbers puts
