

Msgr. Krieg, Rev. Gerling to be honored

GENEVA — The board of directors of Finger Lakes Social Ministry plans to honor Monsignor Gerard C. Krieg, pastor of St. Stephen's Church, and Rev. W. James Gerling, pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Geneva at a "Sharing the Light" award dinner Tuesday, June 6.

Bishop Matthew H. Clark will be a special guest at the dinner, which will be a fundraiser for Finger Lakes Social Ministry. The keynote speaker will be Jack Balinsky, president of diocesan Catholic Charities, of which Finger Lakes Social Ministry is a regional office.

The agency's board plans to make presentation of the "Sharing the Light" award an annual event. Recipients are to be individuals who share the "light" that God has given him or her with others and demonstrate a significant commitment to individuals, families and communities in the Finger Lakes region.

Monsignor Krieg, pastor of St. Stephen's Parish since 1983, has been actively involved in a variety of community projects. He is president of Geneva's Interfaith Council and a member of the Knight of Columbus.

The monsignor said his goal in the community is to foster greater public support "for all the wonderful projects that provide for the needs of others — the Center of Concern, the daily lunch program, the People's Food Pantry."

Asked to describe his greatest accomplishment, Monsignor Krieg replied, "Simply to be a parish priest who focuses the people on their love for Christ out of which will flow the love for one another and for the community."

The Rev. Gerling has been pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Geneva for 15 years. He has been involved with such community efforts as Unity Day, The Whale Watch, the Community Playground, the Community Lunch Program and Habitat for Humanity. He is also one of the creators of the "Miracle in the Park" effort, which he described as "a fun way to involve people in the cause of serving the hungry in our area."

The Rev. Gerling said his vision for Geneva is for the Ontario County city to be "a place where all people's basic needs for food, housing, health care and education are everyone's concern, and where our great diversity can be celebrated."

Tickets for the dinner cost \$30 each. Groups may reserve tables for eight for \$200 per table.




