Two teams get top seeds; Crusaders come up big

They enter sectional play as their area's best. Will the same still hold true in two weeks?

Geneva DeSales' baseball team, along with Our Lady of Mercy softball, are the No. 1 seeds as Section 5 playoff action begins this week. Also at DeSales, the Saints' softball squad has gained a No. 2 seed.

As those three clubs prepared for sectionals, two Elmira Notre Dame teams have already reached the Section 4 Class D quarterfinals with first-round wins.

ND softball, seeded 14th, scored a 3-2 win over No. 3 Roxbury last Friday, May 26, in Bainbridge, N.Y. The Crusaders (6-13) made single runs in the third, fourth and fifth innings hold up, thanks especially to relief pitcher Tania Meck's efforts in the seventh inning. She struck out the final two batters with the tying run on second base.

ND was scheduled to face No. 6 Lansing in quarterfinal play May 30. Semifinals are scheduled for June 1 against either No. 2 Groton or No. 7 Edmeston, with the title game June 3.

The Crusader baseball team, seeded No. 5 in Class D, rolled to a 15-3 win over No. 12 Jefferson May 26 at Susquehanna Valley. Joel Stephens and Steve Janeski each homered for ND.

ND was set to play No. 4 Deposit May 30, with the semifinals June 1 against either No. 1 Lansing or eighth-seeded Lauren. The championship game is June 3.

At DeSales, the baseball team (16-2) entered Section 5 Class D play as the No. 1 seed and Finger Lakes West co-

champion. The Saints were scheduled to play No. 16 Belfast May 30, with the winner facing either No. 8 Andover or No. 9 Canaseraga June 2.

DeSales' softball team (12-5), seeded No. 2, received a first-round bye. The Saints are scheduled to face either No. 7 Canaseraga or No. 10 Angelica June 2.

Mercy softball (19-2) is the top seed in Section 5 Class BB. The Monarchs will play either No. 8 Aquinas Institute (13-8) or No. 9 Wilson Magnet June 2. A meeting with the Little Irish would serve as a rematch of the Private-Parochial League Tournament title game, which the Monarchs won 8-4 over Aquinas May 27 at McAvoy Park.

McQuaid baseball (16-6) got the No. 5 seed in Section 5 Class AAA. The Knights were scheduled to play No. 12 Penfield May 30, with the winner facing No. 4 Brockport or No. 13 Rush-Henrietta in the June 2 quarterfinals.

Aquinas Institute baseball (13-11), seeded 10th in Section 5 Class AAA, was set to play No. 7 Webster May 30. The winner plays No. 2 Fairport or No. 15 East June 2.

Bishop Kearney baseball (7-12), seeded No. 11 in Section 5 Class A, was set to play No. 6 Waterloo May 30. The winner takes on No. 3 Honeoye Falls-Lima or No. 14 Cuba-Rushford June 2.

Bishop Kearney softball (11-10), seeded No. 8 in Section 5 Class CC, was scheduled to play No. 9 Sodus May 31. The winner advances to a June 2 meeting with No. 1 Wellsville.

Nazareth Academy softball (8-11), seeded 10th in Section 5 Class CC, was scheduled to face No. 7 Cuba-Rushford May 31. The winner will play No. 2 Warsaw June 2.

McQuaid sophomore advances to state play

The life of Riley has been pretty pleasant all spring. Now, Chad Riley has put himself in position to do some really high living.

Riley, a McQuaid Jesuit sophomore, advanced to state-tournament play by winning the Section 5 tennis state qualifier Thursday, May 25, at Mid-Town Tennis Club.

As was the case in the Section 5 Class A title match 12 days earlier, Riley's vic-

tim was Brighton's Jeremy Wurtzman. He defeated the seventh-grader 6-3, 6-4 in the finals.

Riley had advanced to his meeting with Wurtzman by posting a 6-0, 6-0 semifinal win over Pittsford Sutherland's Dave Kroll May 24 at Mid-Town.

Riley, who has not lost a set this year, will compete in state play at the National Tennis Center in Flushing Meadow this Friday and Saturday, June 2-3.
