

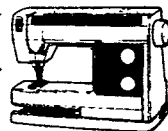

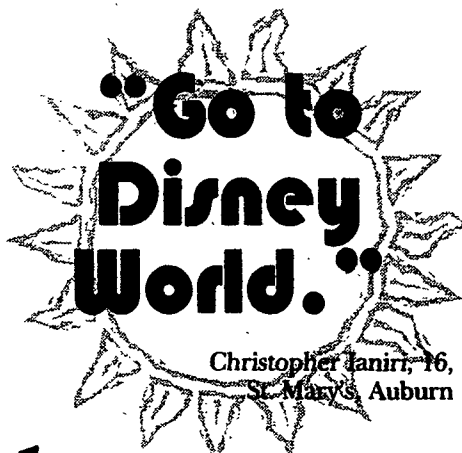
Of course, the beauty of celebrating another new year is that we always get a chance to redeem ourselves! So let's work on carrying out our goals throughout 1996.

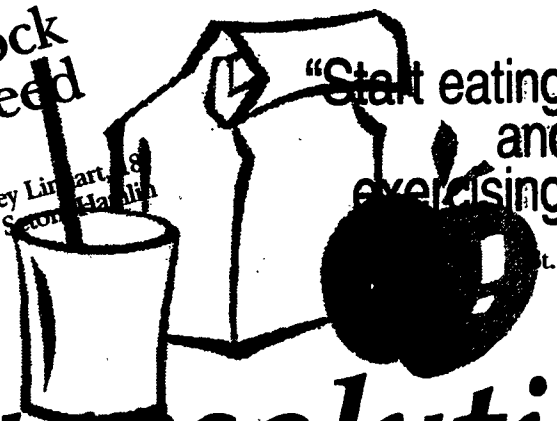
