the very thing that caused the jubilee," Richard said.

The couple credited their Catholic faith with sustaining their marriage through good times and bad, times that began in London during the first wave of German bombings in September 1939. The couple were married on Sept. 17 during a two-day leave Richard had taken from his duties in the British Army.

"The really strong thing in our marriage is the Lord," commented Bridget, who was born in Ireland and living in London when she met her future husband. "We really think along the same lines."

In fact, so intertwined are the couple in thoughts and feelings that their mere presence refutes stereotypical portrayals of the Irish and English as mutually antagonistic peoples, Richard stated.

"They say the Irish and the English can't get along, but I'd say we're proof that it can work," he commented.

Having moved to the United States in 1953, the couple raised two children here and were — and still are — active in their parish. When asked what kept them together, Richard responded:

"I think it's tolerance, patience ... it's also a deep caring between the two of us."
