"I've been playing softball since I was real little," Lisa said. "And a lot of my friends play softball. I can relate to those people more."

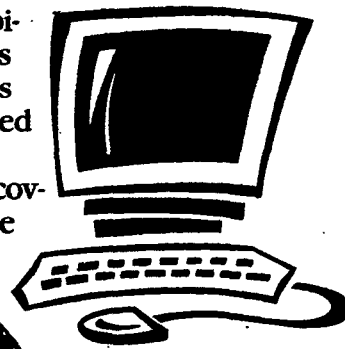
So Lisa opted against the school musical, and reduced her part-time working hours until the softball season ends. In the meantime, the Nazareth pitcher feels comfortable about settling on
