more together, it ends up becoming a better product," said Sister Slyck, who has served as a teacher and pastoral associate in Corning since 1967.

Father Spilly points to the parish school as a good example of the virtues of clustering. He noted that enrollment at All Saints Academy in Corning hovered around 200 when the cluster began, but it now stands at 425 students in grades pre-K through 8. The pastor attributes this rise to the ability of the four churches to work together to promote the school.

As Father Spilly looks back upon his stint in Corning and Painted Post, he expresses satisfaction about the cluster's progress.

"It's certainly been challenging, hard, uplifting," he said. "I can only say that the six years have been very worthwhile in terms of being a priest and ministering to so many people."


Cluster parishioners share positive sentiments about Father Spilly's ef-


