- Our Lady of Mercy girls' swimming, which placed fourth in the Section 5 Class B meet and achieved a top-15 ranking in this year's state

- Mercy girls' cross-country, which earned a No. 3 finish in the Section 5 Class BB girls' meet.
- Aquinas cross-country, which placed fourth in the Section 5 Class BB boys' meet. AQ's Brian Oster gained a 10th-place individual finish at that race.
- Bishop Kearney cheerleading, which placed second in the Section 5 Class B Fall Tournament.
- Aquinas cheerleading, which finished third in Class A in the sectional fall competition.
- Nazareth Academy girls' volleyball, which reached the Section 5 Class B semifinals. The Lasers' final record was 17-6.

## Obituary

### Richard Pilliter, baseball coach

Richard J. Pilliter, a longtime teacher and coach at Aquinas Institute, died Oct. 13, 1996. He was 51.

Mr. Pilliter, a Rochester native, graduated from Holy Cross School in 1959 and from Aquinas in 1963. He received his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Windsor, Ontario; and his teacher's education certification from Nazareth College of Rochester.

Mr. Pilliter taught history and political science at Aquinas for 27 years. He was also a guidance counselor for 10 years and chairman of the social studies department for 15 years.

He was also renowned for his coaching prowess, accumulating an overall record of 337-193 in 23 years as AQ's head baseball coach. The Little Irish won 15 City-Catholic League titles, as well as Section 5 championships in 1979 and 1984, under his guidance. Mr. Pilliter also coached freshman and junior varsity

basketball, and was a varsity football assistant.

Mr. Pilliter was acknowledged for his academic and athletic achievements in 1995 by being inducted into the Aquinas Hall of Fame. He was also presented with an award for Excellence in Secondary School Teaching by the University of Rochester in 1990.

He is survived by his father, Richard L. Pilliter; sister, Marie Hathaway; friend, Margaret Whalen; nephew, Robert (Kim)

Hathaway; and nephews, Charles and Stephen Hathaway.

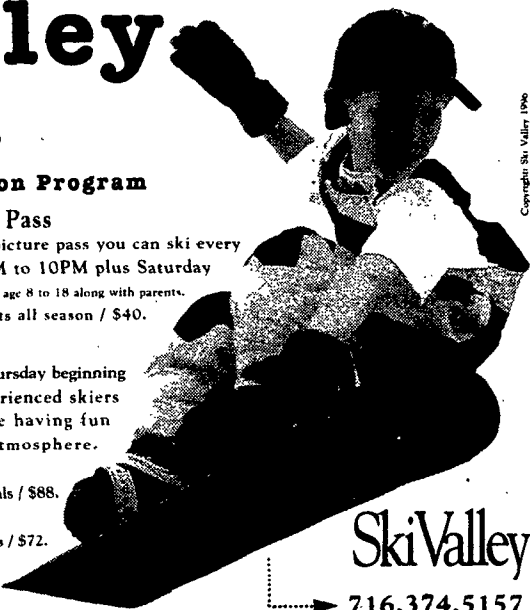
