How can I help a grieving friend?

People in early grief often are shocked and unable to believe what has happened. They may feel angry or guilty and have difficulty organizing their life, sleeping or eating. If you wish to help you should encourage expressions of feelings. This means listening to the grieving as they talk about the death and their pain over it. You can also provide practical assistance such as babysitting, organizing the household and driving your friend to appointments.
