The supply will be endless like the loaves as the fishes.

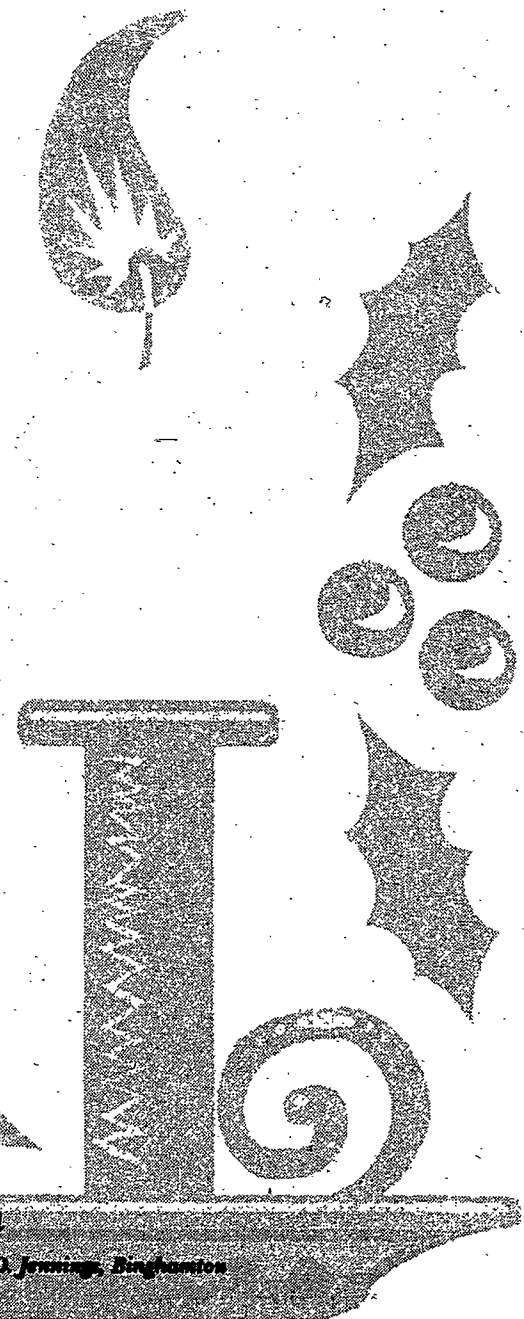
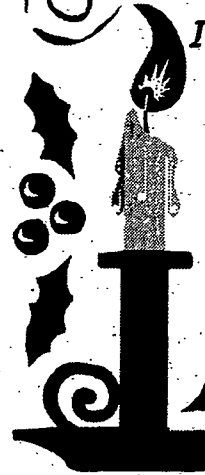
I will fill all the stockings and not leave a track.

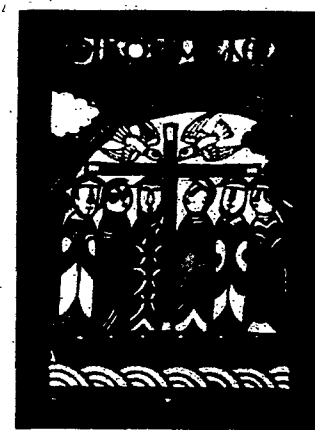

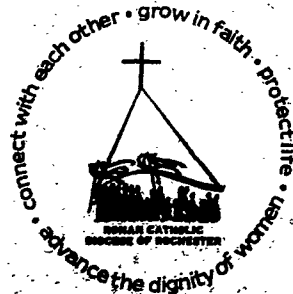
