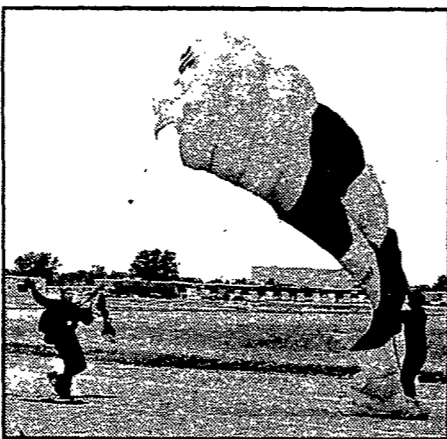


## Off we go

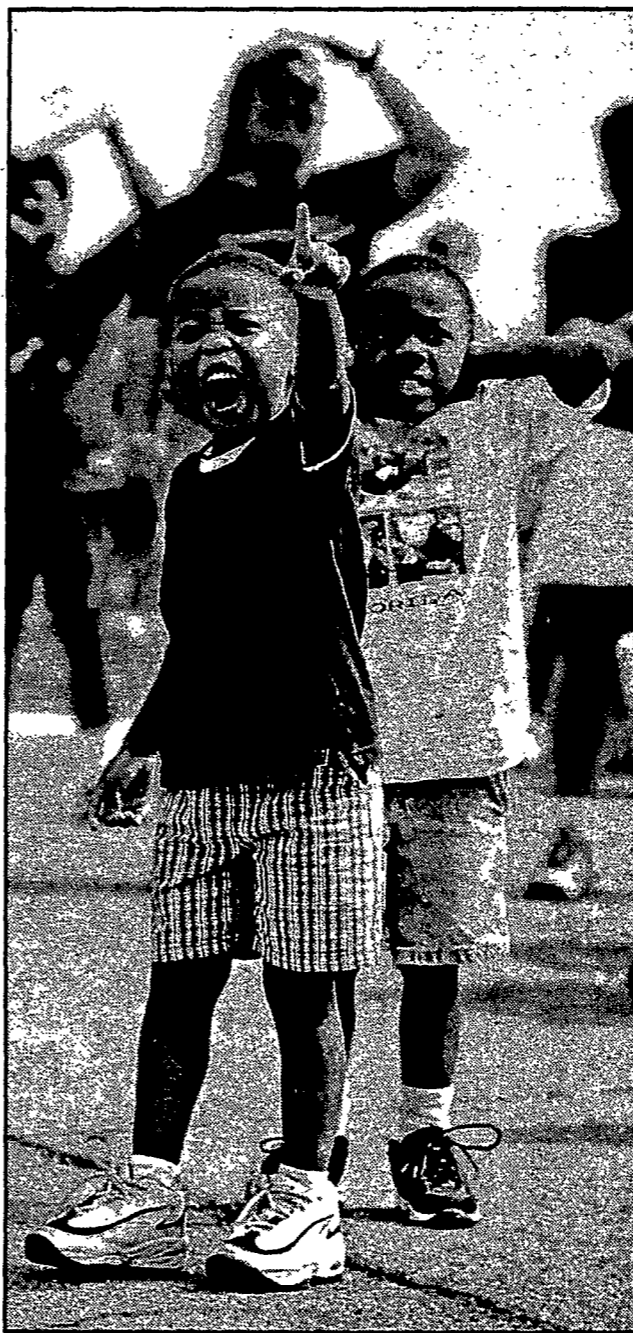
