

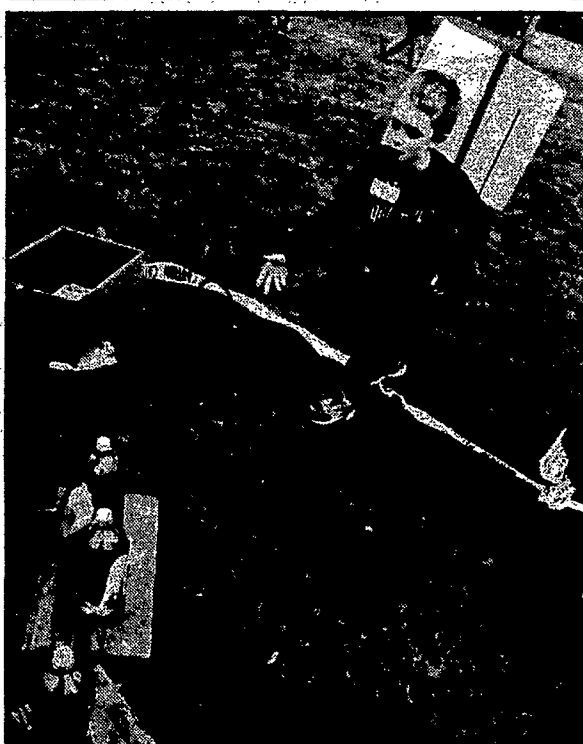

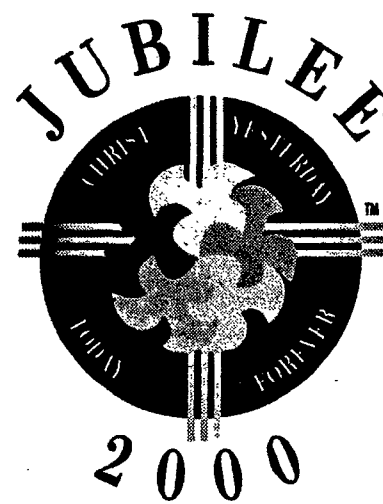


Rory Keyes, 7, of St. Catherine's Parish in Mendon, plays the "Ring Toss."
