### Exhibit features Maryknoll nun's art

"Lost in the Beauty of her God," an exhibit of the late Maryknoll Sister Marie Pierre Semler's art, will be on display at St. Dominic's Parish Center, W. Main Street, Shortsville, July 16-22. Times are 2-8 p.m. Monday-Saturday and 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. Sundays.

The exhibit will include drawings, paintings, wood and stone sculptures, poetry and writings from a collection of more than 1,000 pieces.

Sister Semler's story was featured in the May 9, 1996, issue of the *Catholic Courier*. Born Bertha Josephine in 1901, Sister Semler grew up in Chili and entered the Maryknoll order to become a missionary to China. However, a heart condition made travel too dangerous for her. She died in 1993 having spent her service with the order as an artist based in Ossining, N.Y.

Sister Semler's grandnephew and his wife, David and Mary Hovac of Farmington, are guardians of the artwork which they offer to parishes for exhibits.
