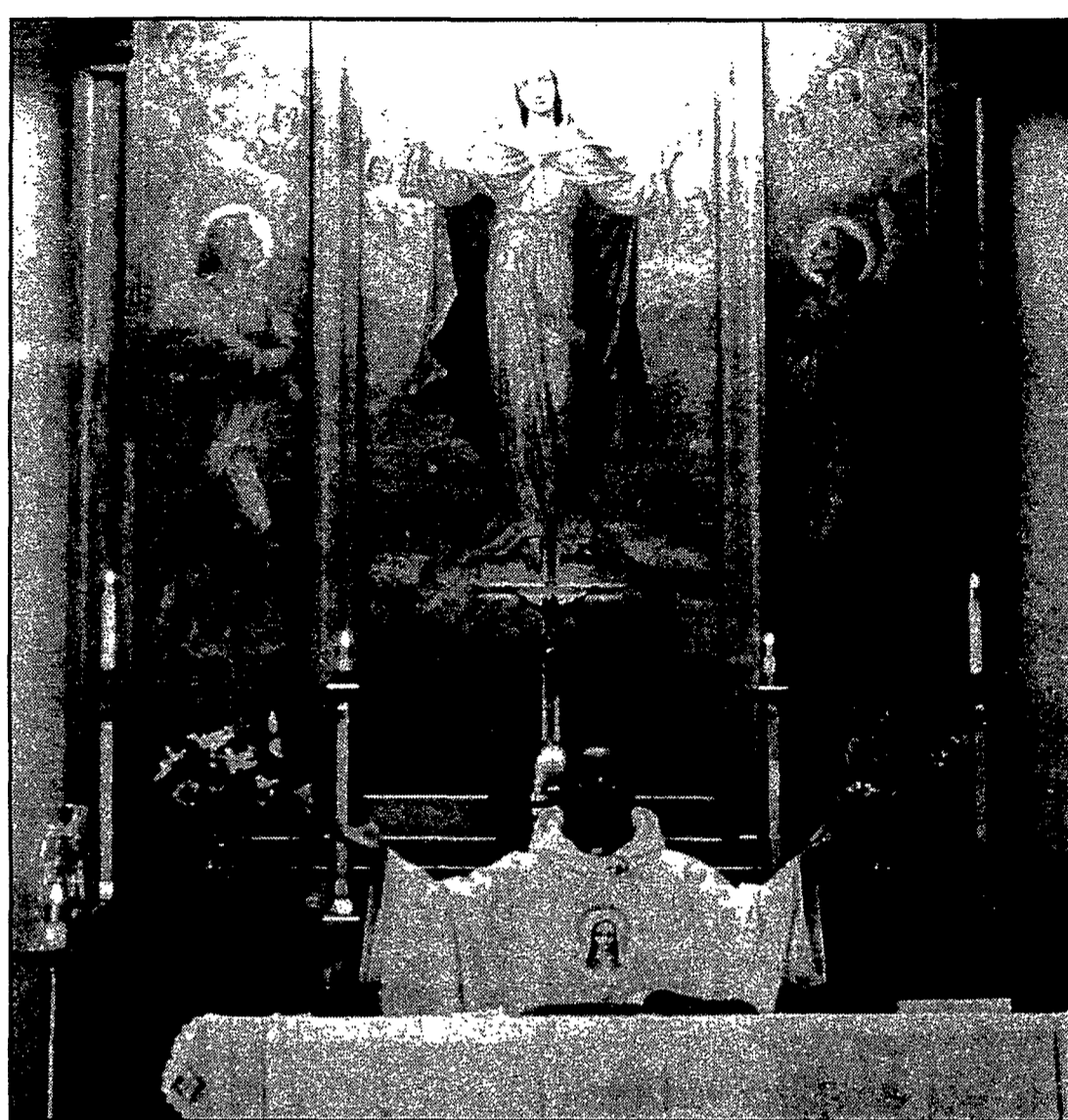

## 'Do Lunch for the Homeless' to help open new women's shelter

Catholic Family Center is encouraging the community to "Do Lunch for the Homeless," particularly for a certain target group.

"We're hoping to raise enough to open a new women's shelter next year," said Bill Keenan, fund development director for the center.

The annual "Do Lunch for the Homeless" campaign generally brings in about \$20,000, according to Keenan. He said more than \$100,000 has been raised toward the \$210,000 needed for the women and

children's shelter. The shelter would supplement Women's Place, one of two emergency shelters the center operates. The other is for men.

Parishes, individuals, businesses and other groups donate money they save by brown bagging lunch instead of eating out.
