Domestic violence services scheduled

The Rochester Diocese will host prayer services in solidarity with people affected by domestic violence this month, designated Domestic Violence Month.

Services will be held at 7 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 4, at St. Mary Church, 15 Clark St., Auburn; 3 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 7, at St. Mary of the Lake Church, 905 N. Decatur St., Watkins Glen; and at 3 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 21, at Sacred Heart Cathedral, where Bishop Matthew H. Clark will preside. The cathedral service will be bilingual and is co-sponsored by the Diocesan Women's Commission and Catholic Charities "Respect Life" Initiative.

"Everyday we see violence in the media and on television, but it's important that we realize that violence is also happening in our homes, places which should be the safest," Bishop Clark said in a press statement. "Domestic violence violates the dignity of humans who are made in the likeness of God. Our local Church, and the Church as a whole, denounces the sin of domestic violence and works toward leading those affected by such acts to restored dignity through healing and recovery."
