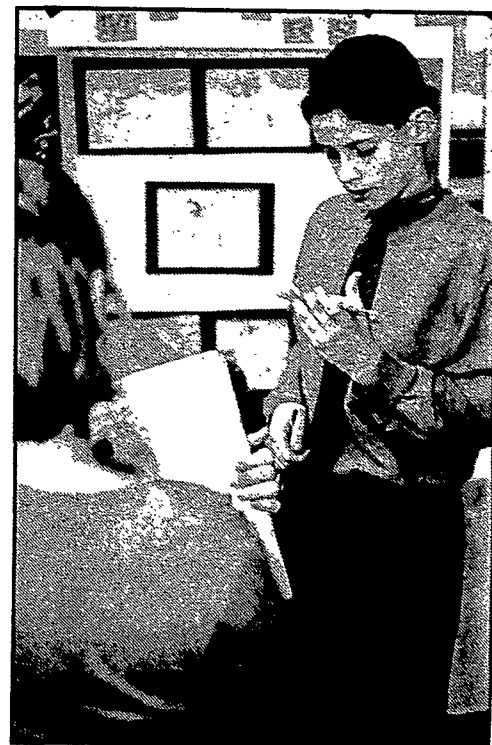

### Easter Conference features Fr. Groeschel

HAMBURG — Nationally known speaker Father Benedict Groeschel is scheduled to be the featured presenter at an Easter Conference at the Erie County Fairgrounds' Agri-Center April 13 and 14.

Father Groeschel is a psychologist, author, founder of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal in the Bronx and a frequent guest speaker on the Eternal Word Television Network. He established the Trinity Retreat Center for clergy in Larchmont, N.Y., and gives conferences around the country. He will speak on the direction of the Catholic Church in the 21st century.
