St. John the Evangelist Church, 549 Humboldt St., Rochester, is hosting a "Konbit" — which is Haitian-Creole for "party" — on Saturday, Aug. 17, from 5-8 p.m. to benefit Haitian Outreach Pwoje Espwa. Pwoje Espwa means "Project Hope" in Creole.

Begun by parishioners at Corpus Christi Church in Rochester, H.O.P.E. is now an independent, not-for-profit organization that has worked since 1995 in Borgne, a rural community in Haiti, the Western Hemisphere's most impoverished nation. H.O.P.E. volunteers have promoted grassroots development in Borgne's educational, health-care and economic systems. Among the projects H.O.P.E. volunteers have helped to create are a health clinic and a solar-powered water-purification system.

Music at the Konbit will be provided by Jaguar, and a Haitian buffet will be available for \$7 per adult and \$4 for children 12 and under. The event is free and open to the public.
