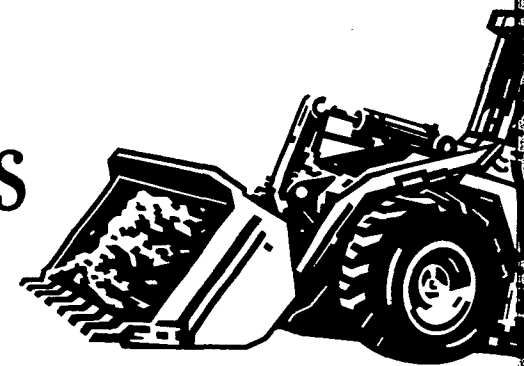


Site Work Begins This Fall

While the 41-acre campus will remain largely unchanged to preserve the beauty of the natural landscape, site surveys, ground clearing and grading will begin, preparing the way for construction commencement in the Spring of 2003.
