

# 2002-2003 Update: Frequently asked financial questions related to the issue of sexual abuse of children by clergy

The issue of sexual abuse of children by priests and deacons remains a serious issue for our Church. Since 1991, the Diocese of Rochester and its parishes, schools and agencies have been operating under a policy of handling such abuse. The diocese took a major step in 2003 to include elements of the Code of the Protection of Children and Young People adopted over a year ago by the Bishop of the United States in 2002. Many of those elements were adopted for victims' immediate investigation of all claims of abuse, training for clergy and staff and the creation of a panel of lay experts to advise the Bishop on these matters. Lay experts have been part of diocesan policy.

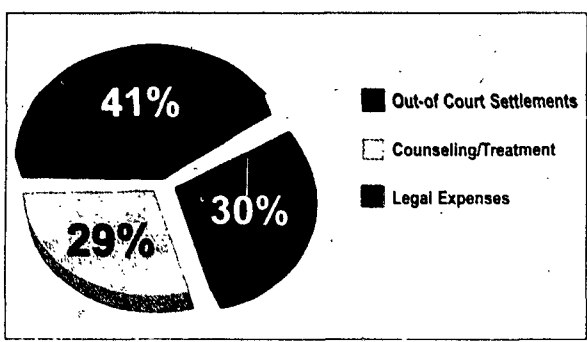

**Q** How are costs associated with the sexual abuse of children by priests and deacons paid?

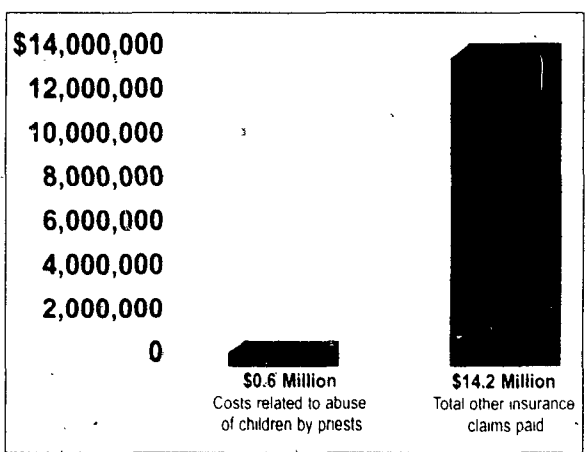
**A** Individual parishes have not paid any expenses associated with these cases. All costs for claims related to the sexual abuse are paid by the diocesan insurance program. The diocese runs an insurance program for all parishes, schools, and agencies of the diocese covering a full-range of insurance issues such as fire, property damage, theft, liability, auto, workers compensation, etc. The diocese charges premiums to all parishes, schools and agencies to cover the costs of buying insurance policies, processing claims and payment of claims within the deductible limits retained by the diocesan insurance program.

**Q** How much has the Diocese paid related to the sexual abuse of children by priests and deacons?

**A** For the period from July 1, 1992 through June 20, 2003, the diocese has paid a total of \$608,000 for counseling for victims and their families, settlements with victims and legal expenses.

In contrast, over the same ten-year period, the diocesan insurance program paid a total of \$14.2 million for all other insurance claims, such as property damage, personal liability, workers' compensation, auto and boilers for parishes, schools and agencies of the diocese.

**Q** Is my contribution used to pay legal settlements and expenses?

**A** All of the ministries of the Diocese of Rochester are made possible through the generosity of our donors. These contributions enable our local church to carry out a wide variety of ministries that keep it healthy and vibrant, and allow it to meet the spiritual needs of our faithful. Like any business or organization of its size, however, the diocese and its parishes, schools and agencies deal with the costs of doing business, including the need to maintain insurance and pay insurance claims.
